What is Lent and Why Does It Last 40 days? Lent is a season of forty days, not counting Sundays, which begins on Ash Wednesday and ends on Holy Saturday. The forty days represents the time Jesus spent in the wilderness, enduring the temptation of Satan and preparing to begin his ministry. Lent is a time of repentance, fasting and preparation for the coming of Easter. It is a time of self-examination and reflection. Christians focus on their relationship with God, often choosing to give up something or to give of themselves for others.

Holy Week Service Information-

- **Palm Sunday, April 9th at 4:30pm: Stations of the Cross-**Family friendly, multi-sensory way to imagine walking with Jesus through the last week of his life as he gave up his life because he loves us so much. Perfect for those who can't make the Good FridayTenebrae service.

GROW CONTINUED :

- **Good Friday, April 14th at 7:00pm: Tenebrae Service-**Tenebrae is a latin word meaning darkness. This service allows us to walk with the disciples as they face the dilemma of risking their lives to stand up for Jesus or to fade away in darkness during his arrest. It also helps us see the depth of Jesus' love for us as he boldly offered himself to the cross for our forgiveness and eternal life. To know the joy of Easter, we must know how much Jesus has given so that we can live with him!
- **Easter Sunday Service, April 16th at 8:30am & 10:45am: Celebration of Resurrection-**This is the happiest day of the Christian year! We'll sing and praise and welcome new people to faith and life in Jesus Christ through a Celebration of Faith, Confirmation, Membership, and Baptism!
